OBJECTIVES AND RATIONALE BEHIND THE LOTTERY

Distribution of additional garden beds or greenhouse shelf space

Provides a fair distribution process for allocating **primary bed/**temporary garden beds or shelf spaces

Supports members wanting additional garden space

Provides members wanting additional garden space the opportunity to grow more than a primary garden space provides

Keeps all garden beds maintained

Temporary assignments are good for the entire garden area as it keeps otherwise unassigned primary beds maintained



LOTTERY PROCESS – WHAT IS INCLUDED

Primary Assignments

- Membership is based on one per apartment regardless of apartment occupancy. All members are eligible for one primary garden space and/or greenhouse shelf. Current primary bed/shelf space is <u>not</u> included in the lottery.
- Only Primary space assignments are good for as long as the member apartment remains in good standing.
- New primary assignments are included in the lottery.

Temporary Assignments

- Temporary space assignments through the lottery are good for one calendar year only.
- Members may request more than one temporary assigned space.



LOTTERY ELIGIBILITY

HS Garden Club Member in good standing

The member continues to pay dues, follow Club rules and requests additional garden or greenhouse space.

Assignment of a primary garden/greenhouse space

Members may only request temporary space if they are assigned a primary garden/greenhouse space.

Assignment only to a member

Primary/temporary space is assigned to a specific member. Space may not be assigned on behalf of another person.

Elevated beds

Elevated beds (both primary & temporary) are based on mobility.



LOTTERY PRE-PROCESS

Garden Club Member Questionnaire

By <u>November 4th</u>, each member completes a questionnaire indicating their preferences for the following year; e.g., keep their same primary bed, change beds, request additional shelf space. **Completing this questionnaire accurately is critical to the member.**

Dues Payment

By <u>November 4th</u>, all members must pay their dues (\$30) for the following year. This allows their preferences for the following year (from the questionnaire) to be included in the data compilation phase.

Data Compilation

Every <u>November</u>, the Treasurer compiles the member questionnaire requests, e.g., # primary beds needed, # temporary beds available.



LOTTERY PROCESS CONDUCTED AT BUSINESS MEETING

STEP 1

Immediately Prior to the <u>December</u> Business Meeting

- Immediately before the December Business Meeting, the Treasurer conducts the lottery to determine the order for members to select temporary space.
- Each of the lotteries is conducted in order from #1 to #8 and includes the names of all members based on their response to the questionnaire.
- There may be multiple iterations for a lottery.
- A lottery may not be conducted if there were no requests.



LOTTERY PROCESS CONDUCTED AT BUSINESS MEETING

STEP 2

At the **December** Business Meeting

Members select space based on how their name was drawn:

- 1 Requests for a primary elevated bed (priority for mobility impaired)
- 2 Requests for temporary elevated bed space (priority given to mobility impaired)
- 3 Requests for a primary in-ground bed (includes names from #1 not receiving an elevated bed)
- 4 Requests to change the location of a primary bed
- 5 Requests for temporary in-ground bed space (includes names from #2 not receiving an elevated bed)
- 6 Requests for a primary shelf in the greenhouse
- 7 Requests to change the location of a primary shelf in the greenhouse
- 8 Requests for a temporary shelf in the greenhouse



LOTTERY POST-PROCESS

Garden Bed and Greenhouse Shelf Hand-Off

If a member relinquishes a garden bed or greenhouse shelf, the member is responsible for clearing the shelf or cleaning out the garden bed by the end of December.

2026 Assignments

- Members take ownership of new space, based on the lottery, on 01 January 2026.
- Members should complete any fill-and-till questionnaires in December based on 2026 assignments.
