## Old Farmer's Almanac Fall/Winter Garden To-Do

- Per the National Gardening Association, there is a 10% probability that Dallas will get its first freeze by November 4<sup>th</sup> with a 50% probability of getting the first freeze November 25<sup>th</sup> <a href="https://garden.org/apps/frost-dates/Dallas,%20Texas/">https://garden.org/apps/frost-dates/Dallas,%20Texas/</a>. Harvest vegetables that do not tolerate frost/cold: tomatoes, zucchini, peas, beans, winter squash & pumpkins.
- 2. Prepare herbs for Winter
  - Sage is a perennial but frost stops growth. So cut some to dry for Thanksgiving
  - b. Rosemary should be protected or brought inside
  - c. Basil won't survive a winter so dig some up and bring it inside in small pots.
  - d. Mulch oregano
- 3. Add some compost/manure before the ground freezes. Then add a light layer of straw to prevent soil erosion or sow a cover crop such as winter rye to improve the soil.
- 4. Prune raspberries, plant blackberries, mulch blueberries and strawberries.
- 5. Winterize roses by mulching, removing dead/diseased canes.
- 6. Empty any outdoor containers and store them upside down.

## Thoughts on 2026

- 1. Start planning for the spring.
- 2. Decide what type of till-and-fill (if any) you want for 2026.
- 3. Per the National Gardening Association, there is a 10% probability that Dallas will get its last freeze on March 28<sup>th</sup> with a 50% probability the last freeze will occur on March 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- 4. If you plan to grow tomatoes/peppers from seed, they need to be started 6-to-8 weeks before the last frost, if you want an earlier crop.
- 5. Flower seeds, such as zinnias, should be sown outdoors after last frost.
